Day & Zimmermann (D&Z) completed our first solar project in 2008 when Mason & Hanger, our architecture and engineering division, designed a 120 KW roof-mounted system for the U.S. Mission to the United Nations in Geneva, Switzerland. Since then, D&Z has designed 36 solar installations including parking canopies and roof- and ground-mounted systems. In 2021, with the prompting of our existing utility customers, D&Z made the strategic decision to begin constructing solar as an EPC firm. This led to our selection as the primary contractor building a total of 200 MW in West Virginia starting in 2023.

In a typical spring or fall, D&Z will manage 10-15 simultaneous, schedule-critical outages at power plants across the U.S. and Canada. Each outage involves hiring, organizing, and managing hundreds of craft workers from various trades to perform numerous planned outage scopes. Similar to solar, the outages involve managing hundreds of thousands of parts and performing repetitive tasks such as component assembly, rigging, and welding. An outage can involve more than 10,000 welds, which must be planned, performed, inspected, tracked, and reported. D&Z's planning and expertise separate us from the competition and our KPI measurement system provides the data we need to continuously improve. This helps us provide the highest quality service each and every time.
